



Overview

The Planning Commission collaborates with residents, community partners, and other municipal, regional, and state agencies to create plans that assess community needs

and guide future investment and policy.

The Town Plan is the community road map that lays out the Town's needs, goals, and aspirations. The Plan is implemented through land use regulations such as the Development Regulations and the Capital Improvements Plan.

The Development Regulations guide the Development Review Board and The Zoning Administrator on how to implement land use within the Town of Georgia to meet the expectations laid out in the Town Plan.
